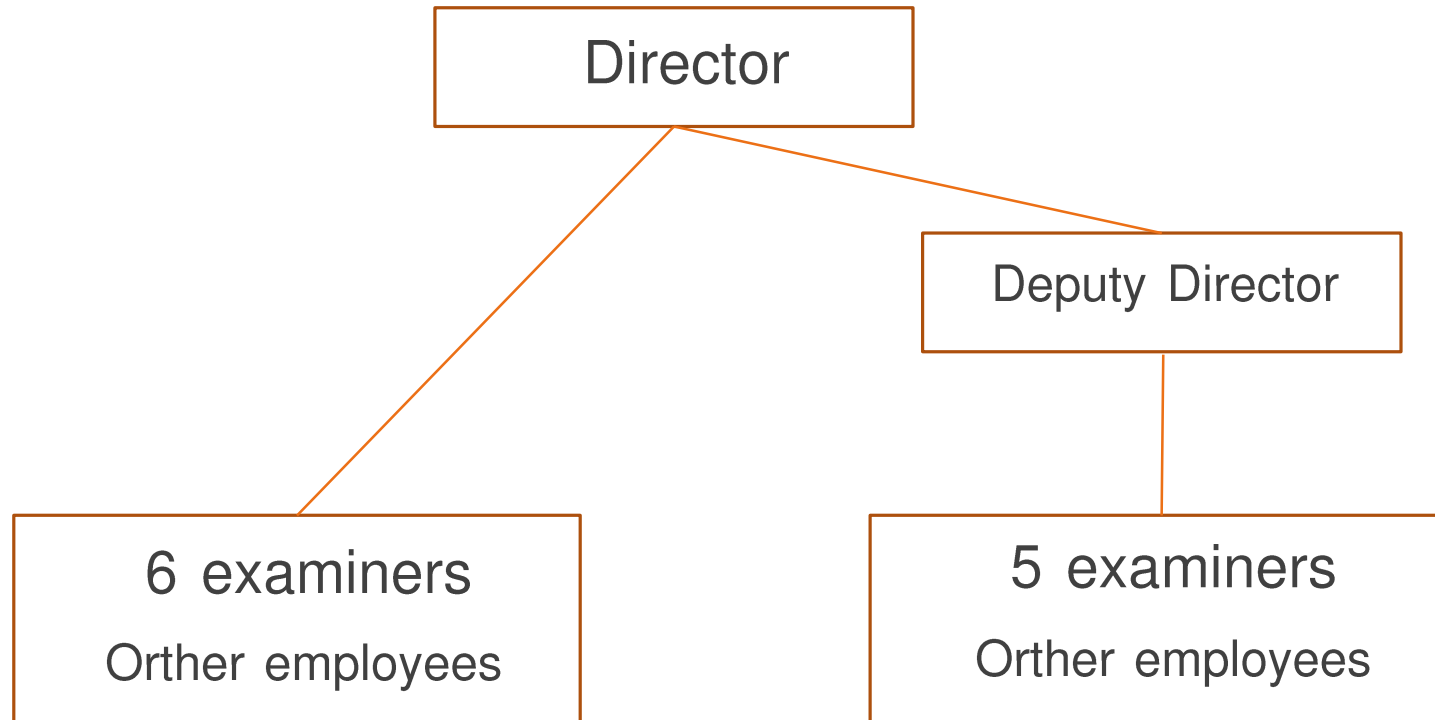
# The Post - Registration Examination Center

# Duties and Responsibilities

---

- Process the applications related to protection titles on industrial property subject matters:
  - + Registration of transfer of industrial property rights;
  - + Changes of name and address of the owner(s);
  - + Renewal and maintenance validity of protection title;
  - + Re-issuance/duplication protection title;
  - + Invalidation of protection title;

# Duties, Responsibilities

- + Manage, update information in the National Registers;
- + Orther tasks.

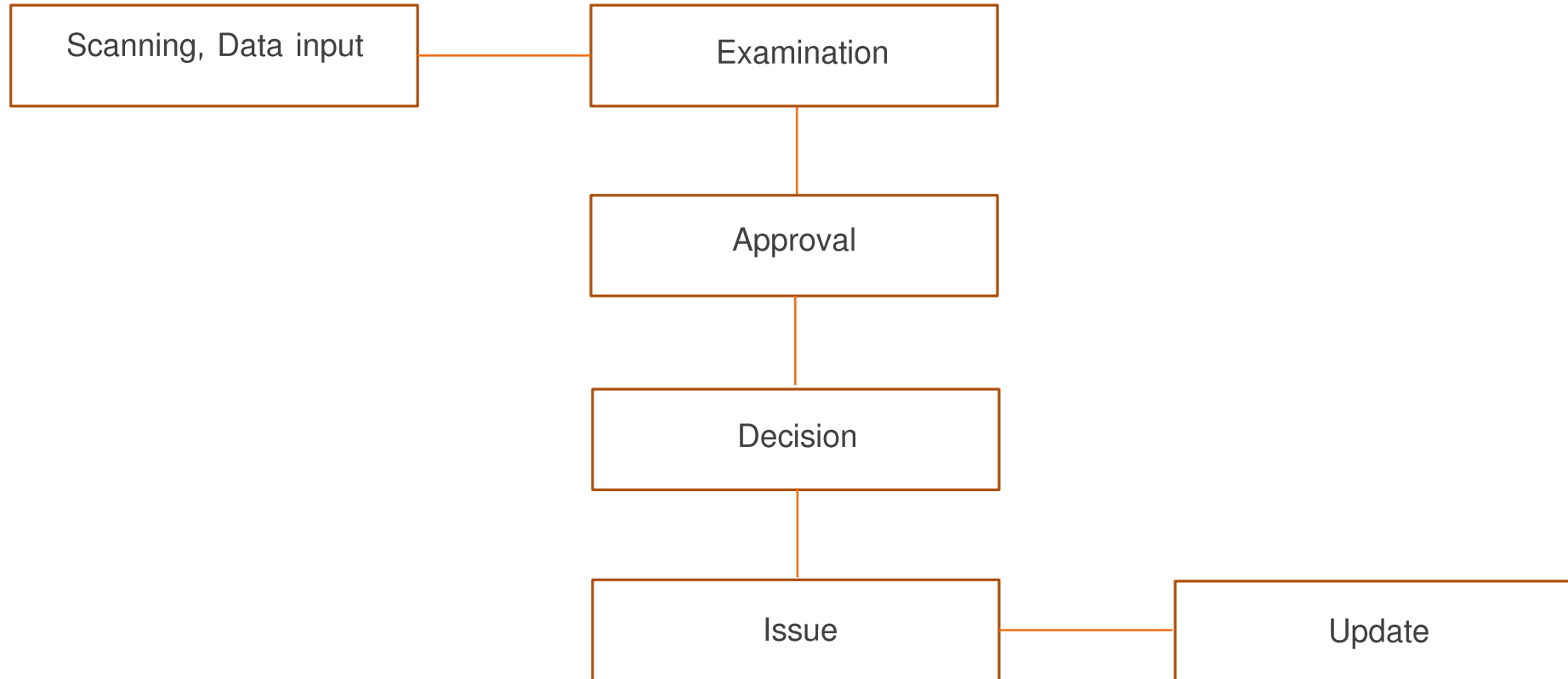

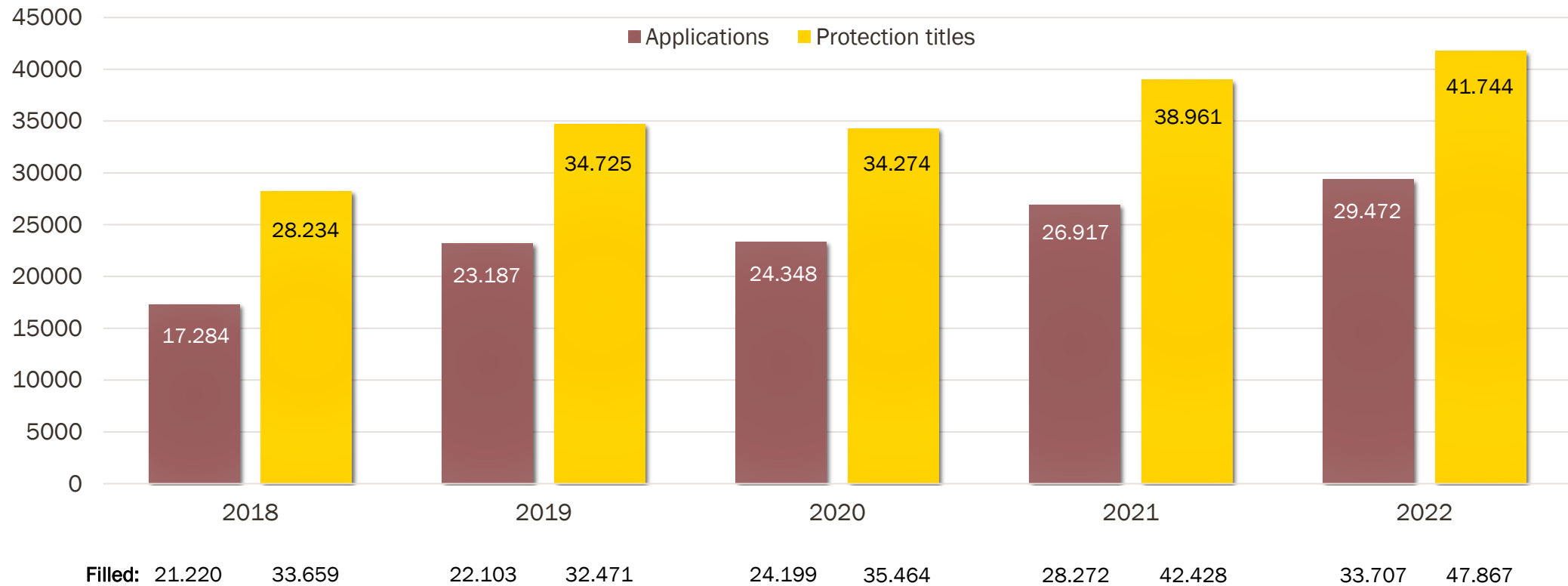
