II. Matters concerning the generation, reproduction and distribution of Industrial design documents and of secondary sources of Industrial design information, i.e. official gazettes.

The bibliographical data and images of the registered industrial designs are Published in the Offical Industrial Designs Bulletin which is issued on the 1 th Bibliographic data includes the classification symbols.

III. Turkey is member of the Locarno Agreement Establishing an International Classification For Industrial Designs so Industrial Design applications are classified According to Locarno Classification system. No other classification systems are applied.

IV. Search file establishment and upkeep

Each Industrial design application is examined for legality. Bibliographic data elements and classification sysmbols are searchable. An examination of applications as to novelty is not performed.

V. Activites in the field of computerized search systems for industrial designs.

An online in-house system is installed using an internal industrial design data base. No external data base is integrated.

The application and registrations procedures, the administration of the design register and the execution of the statistics are completely performed by the EDP Management systems.

VI. Administration of industrial design services available to the public.

Inspection of the industrial design register and of record designs is possible. Register extracts are prepared on reguest for which fees are charged.

VII. Matters concerning mutual exchange of industrial design documents and information

Up to now The Offical Industrial Design Bulletin wasn't submittied to industrial property offices. But we are considering to submit it at least the countries that we are receiving their industrial design gazettes namely Austria, England, Germany and Spain.

VIII. Matters concerning education and training including technical assistance to developing countries.
