# **Annual Technical Report on Industrial Design Information Activities of the Federal Intellectual Property Office of Yugoslavia in 1999**

In 1999, the number of both, national and applications filed under the Hague Agreement has increased. Due to the fact that during 1999, because of the war situation, Industrial Designs Department of the Yugoslav Federal Intellectual Property Office was not able to work normally, the number of registered national applications has dramatically decreased in comparison with previous year.
