Annual Technical Report on Patent Information Activities in 1999

Industrial Property Office of the Czech Republic

I. <u>Evolution of patent activities</u>:

In comparison with the year 1998 there were no substantial changes as to the patent and utility model activities. In 1999, 4 797 patent applications and 1 384 utility model applications were filed, 1 482 patents were granted and 1 368 utility models registered.

II. <u>Matters concerning the generation, reproduction, distribution and use of primary and</u> <u>secondary sources of patent information</u>:

- patent documents and 1368 utility models were printed; abstracts printed on all title pages of patent documents; Official Gazette issued monthly (Part A - Inventions, Utility Models, Topographies, Industrial Design (Part B - Trademarks); abstracts and drawings published in announcements concerning patent applications in the Gazette.
- Printing and photocopying without changes; Gazette printing prepared by DESK TOP PUBLISHING.
- Production of the Official Gazette on CD-ROM continued; the Gazette was also available in the computer network.
- CD-ROM ESPACE PRECES (Patents from the Region of Eastern and Central European States) continued, including also Czech patent documents; 14 discs were produced (vol. 5-10/1998, vol. 1-8/1999).
- CD-ROM PRECES ACCESS (Bibliographic data and abstracts of the patents from the Region of Eastern and Central European States); 2 discs were produced (vol. 2/1998, vol. 1/1999).

III. <u>Matters concerning abstracting, classifying, reclassifying and indexing of technical</u> <u>information contained in patent documents</u>: - Abstracts printed on title pages of all patent documents and in the Gazette - Part A.

IV. <u>Search file establishment and upkeep</u>:

- Patent documents from 16 countries and EPO received; Patent Gazettes from 54 countries, including EPO and PCT received.
- No changes as regards search files for examiners and the public.

V. <u>Activities in the field of computerized and other mechanized search systems:</u>

- Searches carried out in DC STN, DIALOG and QUESTEL.
- Databases PFS EPIDOS in Vienna and EPIDOS in Hague used.
- Creating the search database of Czech and Czechoslovak granted patent documents, published applications and registered utility models continued; data will be made accessible through Internet during 2000.
- Office automation management system used (data since 1986); following databases operated: Patent applications, industrial design applications, register of inventors, register of applicants and register of organizations corresponding with the Office.
- Following CD-ROM search systems used: CASSISS (US), ACCESS (EP), PATOS (DE), PAJ, LEGAL, US SEARCH and GLOBALPAT.
- VI. <u>Administration of the industrial property office library and services available to the</u> <u>public (relating to facilities, e.g., for lodging applications, for assisting clients on</u> <u>searching procedures, for obtaining official publications and registry extracts)</u>:
 - No changes in the library.
 - Methodical and consultation assistance for the public is given in the reading room and service section.

- Reprographic services assured.
- Search systems on CD-ROM used.
- Patent documents on CD-ROM of EP, WO, DE, US, GB, AT, BE, LU, NL, CH, DK, FR, JP available.

- CD-ROM ESPACE-BULLETIN utilized.
- Czech patent documents sent to the public according to thematic profiles defined by the IPC.
- Electronic order forms of patent searches were available through the Internet.

VII. <u>Matters concerning mutual exchange of patent documentation and information</u>

- Paper documents without changes.
- Exchange of CD-ROM carriers.
- Patent applications filed in paper form.

VIII. <u>Other relevant matters concerning education and training in, and promotion of,</u> the use of patent information, including technical assistance to developing countries:

- Various courses and seminars were organized for the Czech public; excursions for enterprises and schools were accepted.
- The Office held the seminar Industrial Property Information 2000.
- Office staff members participated in the seminars and conferences organized by the EPO, e.g. PATLIB, EPIDOS, RIPP training.
- Training for participants from Brunei and St. Lucia organized in cooperation with WIPO.
