Annual Technical Reports on Trademark Information Activities in 2001

I. Evolution of registration activity

In 2001, 806 applications for registration under national procedure were filed with Armpatent . (922 application for 2000), of this number, 759 applications were registered (829 for 2000) and 25 applications refused

2442 notifications were received under the Agreement of Madrid for international registration of trademarks with indication of Armenia (2342 notifications for 2000). The decision was made for preliminary refusal on 455 international registration (400 for 2000) and final refusal on 208.

II. Matters concerning generation, reproduction, distribution and use of primary and secondary sources of trademarks, bulletins on trademarks information.

In 2001 were published 4 numbers of the Official Bulletins "Industrial Property": No 1 (12), No 2 (18), No 3 (19) and No 4(20), the last issue is in the form of CD-ROM.. The bulletins were published in two languages Armenian and Russian.

In the bulletins were published data on 705 registered trademarks and service marks. The Law of the Republic of Armenia on Trademarks, Service Marks and Appellations of Origin and the Rules for execution, filing and examination of trademarks and service marks were published.

III. Matters concerning classifying, reclassifying and indexing of trademark information

Upon registration trademarks, goods and services are classified according to International Classification of Goods and Services (Nice Agreement), and figurative elements of marks are classified according to International Classification of Figurative Elements of Marks (Vienna Agreement).

The list of goods and services of trademark in the application for registration are indicated by the applicants according to ICTS.

Electronic base of data is available on received applications and registered trademarks.

With the help of electronic base search on trademarks is practically carried out by all bibliographic data.

V. Activities in the field of computerized trademark search systems

In 2001 the works were continued on automation and technical re-equipment of the Office. The second version of subsystem "trademarks" and "trade names" was elaborated for the informational system of Armpatent
