# ANNUAL TECHNICAL REPORT for the year 1998 on INDUSTRIAL DESIGN INFORMATION ACTIVITIES

#### I. EVOLUTION OF REGISTRATION ACTIVITIES.

- Changes in the number of applications and grants compared with the previous year:

1. Application: 1.505 (83%)
-Romanian: 626 (61%)
- Foreign: 879 (113%)

2. Grants: 1.347 (68%)

Romanian : 663 (48%)Foreign: 648 (114%)

There was a downward trend in the number of applications filed by Romanian applicants, while the number of applications filed by foreign applicants increased by 13%.
