## Annual Technical Report 2008 on Trademark Information Activities submitted by Georgia (SCIT/ATR/TM/2008/GE)

#### I. Evolution of registration activities

In 2008 SAKPATENTI received 1459 applications under the national procedure, which exceed by 299 the amount received in 2007 (1160). Increase in the number equals 25.8 percent. 874 trademarks were registered under the national procedure which is less by 66 than the amount registered in 2007, percentage being -7.0 percent.

3951 notifications were received on extension the trademarks to Georgia according to the Madrid Protocol of International Registration of Trademarks, which exceed by 166 the amount received in 2007 (3785). Increase in the number equals 4.4 percent.

3531 International marks were protected in 2008.

By December 31, 2008, 14461 national and 21229 International Marks were in force.

8 International Applications and 1 subsequent designation were submitted to the International Bureau in 2008 under the Madrid Protocol of International Registration of Trademarks. Totally, 70 applications were submitted to the International Bureau by December 31, 2008.

All trademark documents are published in the Official Bulletin of Industrial Property, which is issued twice a month. Documents are prepared at the personal workstations whereafter they are forwarded via Local Area Network to the Publication Division where they are printed and copied using a Rhysograph and Xerox copiers.

Since the 1st of January, 2007 "SAKPATENTI" uses the 9th edition of Nice Classification and the 6th edition of the Vienna classification for trademark registration purpose. The applicant is not required to use exact terms of the Nice Classification. Classification of figurative elements is done by the special examiner.

Identification of bibliographic data of trademarks is done with the use of three digit codes in accordance with the WIPO Standard 60.

Other classification systems such as electronic classification system are not used so far.

Bibliographic data elements are searchable on paper files, which are regularly updated.

##### -In-house system

The flexible search system is available for retrieving all kinds of information from the Trademark Database, e.g. capability of searching by different fields (registration number, registration date, owner, legal status, applicant, etc.)

Examination of trademark applications on similarity and identity are performed via the LAN. The database contains data of both national trademarks and trademarks extended to Georgia under international procedures.

##### -External databases

In the course of trademark examination the following databases are also used: the Madrid System databases for international registration - ROMARIN and Express; Express base for symbols protected under Article 6-ter of The Paris Convention on Protection of the Industrial Property Rights; International non-proprietary names database for pharmaceutical substances-INN (Mednet); Lisbon Express base on International Registration of Appellations of Origin.
